1. New Year's Day, being Friday the 1st January.
2. Good Friday, being Friday the 2nd April.
3. Easter Saturday, being Saturday the 3rd April.
4. Easter Sunday, being Sunday the 4th April.
5. Easter Monday, being Monday the 5th April.
6. Independence day, being Sunday the 18th April.
7. The day following Independence day, namely: Monday the 19th April.
8. Worker's Day, being Saturday the 1st May.
9. Africa Day, being Tuesday the 25th May.
10. Heroes' day, being Monday the 9th August.
11. Defence Forces National Day, being Tuesday the 10th August.
12. National Unity Day, being Wednesday the 22nd December.
13. Christmas Day, being Saturday the 25th December.
