IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Primary and Secondary Education, in terms of section 69 as read with sections 9 and 13 of the Education Act [Chapter 25:04], has made the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Tuition and Boarding Fees) Government Schools (Amendment) Regulations, 2023 (No. 1).
- 2. The Education (Tuition and Boarding Fees) (Government Schools) Regulations, 1999, published in Statutory Instrument 411 of 1999, are amended in the First Schedule by the repeal of Part I and substitution of—
