Proclamation 2 of 2023

PROCLAMATION

by

HIS EXCELLENCY THE HONOURABLE EMMERSON DAMBUDZO MNANGAGWA, G.C.Z.M., President of Zimbabwe and Commander-in-Chief of the Defence Forces of Zimbabwe.

WHEREAS section 237(2) of the Constitution of Zimbabwe, provides that a member of an Independent Commission may be removed from office only on the ground that the member concerned has been guilty of gross misconduct;

AND WHEREAS section 187(4) of the Constitution of Zimbabwe, provides that the President may, when he considers it advisable, appoint a tribunal consisting of at least three (3) members;

AND WHEREAS the President issued a Proclamation in Statutory Instrument 172 of 2022 establishing the Tribunal to inquire into the question of removal from office of Commissioner John Makamure of the Zimbabwe Anti-Corruption Commission;

AND WHEREAS certain amendments to the period of hearing of the inquiry are necessary:

NOW, THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers vested in the President as afore said, I do hereby, by this proclamation amend Proclamation 4 of 2022, published in Statutory Instrument 172 of 2022, by insertion in paragraph (d) of the words “with an option of an extension of six (6) months after expiry of the initial five (5) months”.
