Lotteries and Gaming (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023 (No. 8)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Home Affairs and Cultural Heritage has, in terms of section 65 of the Lotteries and Gaming Act [*Chapter 10:26*], as read with sections 16 and 23 of the Betting and Totalizator Control Act [*Chapter 10:02*], made the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Lotteries and Gaming (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023 (No. 8).

2. The Schedule to the Lotteries and Gaming (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003, published in Statutory Instrument 153 of 2003, is repealed and the following is substituted—

3. For Zimbabwe resident applicants the above fees are payable in local currency at the prevailing interbank rate. Non-resident applicants shall pay the fees in United States Dollars (USD).
